

PUBLIC NOTICE for MS4 - WATERSHED PLANNING

The Saginaw Area Storm Water Authority (SASWA) would like to extend an invitation to the general public of Saginaw County to attend a watershed management planning meeting. These meetings will provide the general public with the opportunity to identify desired uses of our region's water resources. The SASWA has developed Watershed Management Plans for the Lower Tittabawassee, Upper Saginaw and Swan Creek Watersheds to assure the storm water in our region stays as clean and pure as possible before discharging from municipal separated storm sewer systems (MS4) to our rivers and drains. We are taking public comment on these plans to determine if they need revisions.
