### SAGINAW TOWNSHIP ANNUAL STATE OF THE ARTS EXHIBITION

APRIL 22, 2012

Entry forms for the year 2012 edition of the annual Saginaw Township State of the Arts Exhibition are available. The annual event is hosted by the Saginaw Township Art In Public Places Committee. This is a juried exhibition with cash prizes totaling approximately \$3,800. Registration is open to all Michigan artists, working in all media, except photography and digital imagery. The registration deadline is March 30, 2012, post marked the deadline date. Artists must submit their art work for jurying on Friday, April 13<sup>th</sup> or Saturday, April 14<sup>th</sup> (12-5 pm), or earlier by appointment. The Art Exhibit will commence on April 22<sup>nd</sup> with the Exhibition to run through May 25<sup>th</sup>.

The Art Juror for this year's Exhibition is Luther B. Hale, a graduate of the University of Evansville, IN, and completed his MA degree at Indiana University, Bloomington, IN, in Art Education and Fine Arts. Beyond his academic work he has been an active member in many art organizations such as the Saginaw Artists Guild, a Michigan Art Educator's Assoc., Midland Artists Guild, and the Michigan Watercolor Society. Mr. Hale has lived in Saginaw since 1961, retired in 1989 from public school teaching. He has also served as a juror for many art exhibits. Since retiring he is devoting his time entirely to his art, concentrating on watercolor painting and acrylics.
